Important information for preparing your trip to Israel:

1. Participants are responsible for:
 - a. Booking flights to and from Ben Gurion airport in Israel. Be ready to pay cancellation fee if you don't obtain tourist visa for Israel (in case it is required for your country - <http://mfa.gov.il/MFA/ConsularServices/Documents/VisaRequirements-Tourists.pdf>), or wait until you are sure of obtaining visa, and only then apply for participation.
 - b. Arranging and paying for your own transportation from/to airport and/or to hosts/meeting points (you may need ILS cash for taxi or Rav Kav for public transport (to be purchased at the train/bus station at airport).
 - c. Please notice that public transportation from/to Ben Gurion airport during the weekend is different than during the week (use Neshet and Amal taxis during the weekend): <http://www.iaa.gov.il/en-US/airports/bengurion/Transportation/Pages/default.aspx>
 - d. Purchasing your own health and travel insurances at home, before arrival and tourist visa, if necessary - see: <https://mfa.gov.il/MFA/ConsularServices/Pages/Visas.aspx>.

- e. Paying individually for your stays at guesthouses, for your own meals, drinks, etc. during the tours, at kiosks, cafes, restaurants, market, etc.
 - f. Please send your valid Letters of Introduction (LOI), to potential hosts when you contact them.
2. On the opening night of the event, Servas Israel will collect **ILS 750 (Israeli shekels)** from each participant to cover program expenses: **entrance fees to sites, guides, lecturers, bus hire, printed/art materials and refreshments (unless specified as "self-paid" in the program), and some unexpected expenses.**
3. Estimated self-paid expenses:
 - a. For guesthouses: Five nights at approximately **ILS 250 per night per person**, depending whether the stay is in a double, triple, or dormitory room (as available) - paid directly at check-in at the guest houses - in ILS cash or credit card.
 - b. For food and public transportation: Approximately **ILS 100 per day per person.**
 - c. In conclusion, to be on the safe side: (based on the current exchange rates)
Pocket money - 5 days multiplied by 25 euros = 125 euros
Conference 190 euros
Accommodation 250 euros (in a double room)
Total - up to 550 euros, for 5 days
 - d. For paying without VAT at guesthouses, you will be asked to show your passport and the blue card received at the airport.
4. Please send your registration form (attached separately) in Word format to: israel@servas.org. (no need to sign if not possible to add digital signature on Word)
5. **Registration will end May 15, 2019, or earlier if the list of 27 participants is full.**
6. **Registration will be confirmed to each participant after receiving evidence of your flights' booking evidence and registration form to israel@servas.org.**
7. Servas Israel organizers will arrange hosts for you for one-night 22 December 2019, near Haifa. You will be able to choose hosts for additional days before and after the event using Servas Online - Find members.
8. Certificates of attendance will be provided upon request.
